PLEASE TAKE CARE

Owners should note that there will be limited security personnel patrolling our Car Show area and the care of your car is your responsibility. Whilst there are organisers at the venue all day, we cannot watch every car. Thus, we request that you keep an eye on your vehicle, or make arrangements with someone nearby should you need to move away.

- Be available to open your car as the interior will need to be accessible. Cars can be locked at the end of judging.
- Do not leave keys in the car unattended.
- All windows and sunroofs are to be closed. Convertibles are to have roofs closed.

Judging Guidelines

This is not a Concours d'Elegance event; it is a show of all BMW Cars. Judging will be based primarily on cleanliness, presentation and the distance travelled of each vehicle. Any dirt, removable mark or residue of cleaning products will be marked down, but originality of parts or accessories is to be ignored. Bonus points are awarded for the general presentation of the vehicle as a display, for example, documents showing the history vehicle, certificates, log books or BMW accessories.

Build Date & Odometer Reading

- Note that the build date is NOT the ADR compliance date.
- If the odometer is in miles, multiply value by 1.6 to calculate km.
- On vehicles with 5 digit odometers, service records will need to be shown if the odometer has been clocked, otherwise the displayed reading will be used.
- Where the displayed distance is not the real distance travelled for any other reason, e.g. change of odometer etc., there must be some evidence showing the real distance travelled by the vehicle. If not, the displayed distance will be used.

Exterior

- **Paintwork** will be judged on the shine, quality of the finish and colour regularity. Points will be deducted for swirl marks, polish in panel gaps. Small chips will be ignored.
- **Brightwork & Trim** will be judged on the shine and quality of finish. Points will be deducted for swirl marks and any remaining product residue.
- **Glass & Lights:** Points will be deducted for swirl marks and damage. Small chips will be ignored.
- **Wheels & Tyres** includes behind the spokes and inside the wheel arches. Points will be deducted for curb rash or product residue remaining. Light dusting and grass in tread as a result of driving to the venue will be ignored.
- **Overall** impression is based on the overall appearance at a distance of a couple of metres.

Interior

- **Seats:** Seat rails and attached trims are included. Particular attention will be paid to crevices between the seams on the seat covering. Points will be deducted for stains, rips, cracks or remaining product residue.
- **Instruments** includes air vent vanes. Points will be deducted for remaining product residue.
- **Floor** includes carpet under floor mats and seats. Points will be deducted for holes, wear or stains.
- **Boot** includes the spare wheel (where fitted) and wheel well, toolkit completeness, and boot covering under the boot liner. The boot should be clear of loose items.
- **Miscellaneous** includes door jams, kick plates, hinges, pedals, roof lining and rear shelf. The interior should be clear of loose items, and the handbook and service booklet should be present.

Engine Bay

- **Compartment:** Painted parts should shine, and match the colour of external paint. This includes the underside of the bonnet, hinges and catches.
- **Engine** should be free of fluid leaks. Factory applied protectant (yellow dots) or data dots will be ignored.
- **Auxiliaries** includes the radiator, fluid reservoirs and fuse box.
- **Hoses, Clamps & Wiring** should shine and be free of product residue.
- **Overall** impression is based on the overall appearance at a distance of a couple of metres.

Other Points

- **Display Presentation** refers to the overall display of the vehicle as a presentation, including other items improving the display.

Distance Calculation

Points for distance travelled will be awarded by comparing the actual distance against the average distance that the vehicle would be expected to have travelled for its age. 20 points will be awarded for 100% of the average. More points will be awarded for greater distances, with an upper limit of 20 points.

$$\text{Distance bonus} = \frac{\text{Actual km travelled}}{\text{Age in months} \times \text{Monthly km allowance}} \times 20$$

(Max 20, rounded down to nearest whole number)
