- Entry is open to BMW Clubs Australia Chapter members and other CAMS Affiliated Club members. Point score for BMW Club Members only.
- Entries will be accepted online only via the BMW Drivers Club NSW website.
- Entries from Drivers aged between 12 and 18 years must signed by a Parent or Legal Guardian, on the official entry form.
- Email confirming acceptance of entries will be sent out after successful registration and payment.
- Entries may be refused in accordance with the provisions of NCR 83.
- Passengers will be permitted provided a valid disclaimer has been signed. Passengers must be age 12 years or over.

5 Event Format

The following schedule is approximate and may be varied by the Clerk of the Course as necessary for safety and smooth running of the Event. All runs shall start and finish in accordance with Article 13 of the National Motorkhana Code. Timing shall be to 0.01 second. Any such variations will be announced in the paddock area.

Event Program

1630-1715 REGISTRATIONS & SCRUTINEERING: Competitors must complete driver registration. Club Membership and valid CAMS Licence must be produced at registration. Your vehicle must pass Scrutineering to be allowed on the Skid Pan. An inspection (similar to annual registration check) will be carried out before Driver Briefing. Emphasis placed



on good brake pedal, steering and no fluid leaks. Remove all loose objects from interior and boot. **(DO NOT BE LATE** otherwise no guarantee of all runs).

1715 – 1730 COMPULSORY DRIVER BRIEFING

1730– 2130 Auto Tests: Tests set from Motorkhana Handbook. Each Driver to complete each test with at least 3 runs per test.

6 Scrutiny Special Requirements

- a) All vehicles
- b) Approved helmets and apparel in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual are to be worn in ALL specials.
- c) Helmets are not required for road vehicles. Enclosed shoes, t-shirt and shorts at a minimum must be worn.
- d) A valid membership card of a CAMS affiliated club and a valid CAMS competition licence for this event, must be presented at Document check-in (If issued, a Vehicle Log book must be presented).

7 Results Prizes and Awards

Results shall be determined by lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, plus any penalties (Penalties shall be in accordance with Article 17 of the National Motorkhana Code). No prizes or awards are issued as part of this Event.

8 Authority of Officials

Any Driver not following a reasonable instruction by an official during the Event may be excluded at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course

9 Insurance

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au

10 PASSENGERS

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy.

- (a) A briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.
- (b) Passengers MUST:
 - i. wear the same protective gear as a Driver
 - ii. Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes
 - iii. Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and disclaimer
 - iv. Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a passenger.
 - v. Be at least 12 years of age
- (c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.
- (d) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS."

10 Postponement/Abandonment/Cancellation

The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event in accordance with the NCR 59

12. Protests

Protests shall be in accordance with Part XII of the CAMS Manual.

13 Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
